



BICYCLE RIDING POLICY & PERMISSION NOTE

PURPOSE:

To give the opportunity for children (who meet the Guidelines below) to use bicycle transport to and from Watsonia North Primary School **in the safest possible manner.**

GUIDELINES:

To bring a bicycle into school grounds, a child needs to:

- **WALK** their bicycle in the school grounds **AT ALL TIMES.**
- Store their bicycle in the allocated racks behind the South Building and lock it up with a secure chain.
- Not interfere with the bicycles of others stored in the rack area.
- Try and ride as safely as possible to and from school.

Any child not consistently meeting the guidelines will have their right to bring a bicycle into the school grounds removed.

IF YOU WISH YOUR CHILD/CHILDREN TO RIDE A BICYCLE TO AND FROM SCHOOL, PLEASE COMPLETE THE SLIP BELOW PRIOR TO YOUR CHILD/CHILDREN COMMENCING RIDING, AND RETURN TO THE SCHOOL OFFICE.
