STUDENT SCHOLARSHIPS

The Department of Education and Early Childhood Development administers more than 25 different student scholarships. Students in Years 4–12 are invited to apply for student scholarships administered by the Department. These school scholarships are for students who are studying in Victoria (Australia) and who are citizens or permanent residents of Australia. The scholarships are offered to primary, secondary and tertiary students and range in value from \$300 to \$2500. They are generally awarded to students who:

- demonstrate academic achievement
- demonstrate participation in their school and local community
- are in financial need (determined by the parents/ guardians being in receipt of a Health Care Card, a

Low Income Health Care Card or a Pensioner Concession Card (card reference number required) or the students themselves receiving the Youth Allowance).
